Windows Vista

Microsoft's latest operating system "Windows Vista" is now becoming available, and some users may be considering upgrading existing computers or purchasing new computers that run this operating system. Microsoft currently offers five different editions of Windows Vista, each one with slightly different levels of functionality; some targeted at Home users, Business users, and some for Multimedia enthusiasts.

We are currently evaluating MedCen running on the various editions of Windows Vista, with the intention of recommending a minimum baseline version for MedCen to run on efficiently - in the same way that we recommend running on Windows XP professional, and not XP Home.

We would suggest delaying purchase of Microsoft Vista in the meantime, and we will undertake to advise our recommendations when we have completed our evaluation.

Service Utilisation Report
