From the 'Wish List'

Every user can have a say about how they want MedCen to work for them. For each update, we try to include as many suggestions or requests that you have made. This update we included:

- ❑ The Claim Schedules window now has a safety check that ensures unique identifiers (doc_code) are correctly set up in the doc_dat table, before allowing the schedules to be run.
- ❑ The Monthly Accounts window now has a new setting that allows you to change the order of which the invoices are printed. You can now order by **Surname**, but the default order will be by **Patno** (as previously set).
- ❑ Various query optimisations have been done to improve the speed of MedCen, this includes:
 - The perdat view, which will improve the speed of many windows including the Clinical Data and Edit Patient windows.
 - Cover Page data summary query on the Clinical Data window.
 - Trial Balance query

Resolved Issues

- ❑ The Pay Accounts window would not display principal doctors as expected after adding or modifying principals in the doc_dat table.
- ❑ The Modify Practitioner Data tool would not save the unique identifier (doc_code) correctly.
- ❑ The Daylog window did not display bold fonts as expected when the option was set in the properties window.
- ❑ The "More Details" button of the Process RSD Message window would not display as expected.
- ❑ The Mental Health Brief Intervention Service e-form for Aoraki practices did not send the patient's phone number.
