


From the 'Wish List'

Every user can have a say about how they want MedCen to work for them. For each update, we try to include as many suggestions or requests that you have made. This update we included:

- ❑ The Coverage of the Clinical Data form now includes Blood Pressures for a patient, under the Measurements heading. Also when printing the Coverage summary, each page now shows the patient details (in case the pages are separated). If you use a custom version of this printed summary, please contact the MedCen support line (0800 633 236) about having this enabled for your custom version.
- ❑ The display name field in the Modify Practitioner Data window (**Tools->Advanced->Modify Practitioner Data**), has its length increased to 50 characters to allow longer names to be entered.
- ❑ The Filed Results window has a new setting that will allow you to specify a date range to use when printing test results. By ticking the **'Use Date Range'** checkbox, MedCen will allow you to put in a start and end date to which the results can be filtered. This new setting can be found in the Filed Results window, on the **'Printing Selections'** page. **Remember:** You can alter the order of the results by right clicking the Filed Results window and choosing **'Properties'**. This will display the Properties window where you can change the **'Order the grid using...'** dropdown list.
- ❑ The Capitation Based Funding Tools window has undergone a number of improvements. The **'Who were...'** field now has two new additions (as shown in the image), details on all the available options are as follows:

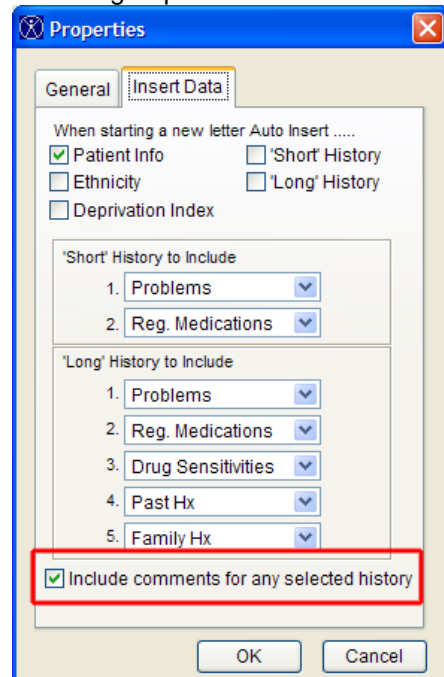
- **Blank** – all regular patients
- **Enrolled** – all regular patients that are enrolled
- **Not Enrolled** – all regular patients that are not enrolled
- **Seen** – all regular patients seen as at specified date
- **Not Seen** – all regular not seen as at specified date



- ❑ The Letter Writer has undergone a number of formatting improvements for inserted data and now can also insert comments that have been stored against a patient's problems, past history or family history.

To enable the comments insertion, right click on the Letter Writer window and left click on **'Properties'**. This will then show the properties window for the Letter Writer (as shown in the image).

Click on the **'Insert Data'** tab at the top and you will see a new checkbox option at the bottom (as shown by the red outline) **'Include comments for any selected history'**.

Resolved Issues

- ❑ The Coveragepage did not show dosage amounts for prescriptions.
- ❑ The Coveragepage would print on an A4 page instead of A5.
- ❑ When the Coveragepage is in 'editable text' mode, it did not print changes as expected.
- ❑ The Appointment book would move 'blocked out' appointments across to the Daylog.
- ❑ When opening a pending lab result from the Inbox, it did not always correctly warn when there are other messages directed at different practitioners.
- ❑ When a block out in the Appointment book was removed, it did not remove the block out as expected.
- ❑ When using the Easy Search Tool to search Read Code descriptions in the Clinical Notes, an error would occur.
- ❑ The Bad Debits window did not show all principle doctors in the 'Practitioner' dropdown list.
- ❑ The Debtor Reports window did not show all principle doctors in the 'For Practitioner' dropdown list.
- ❑ The Pay Account window sometimes did not display rendered amounts as expected.
- ❑ While merging in changes from remote machines, scripts that had their 'Regular' status removed did not merge as expected.
- ❑ Some immunisation claims generated had incorrect prices.
- ❑ When no provider is selected in the Letter Writer, the printed letter incorrectly displays a provider.
- ❑ The ACC 2118 Medical Certificate form had the words 'South Island Pilot'
- ❑ The Easy Search tool did not display expected results when searching the clinical notes within a date range.
